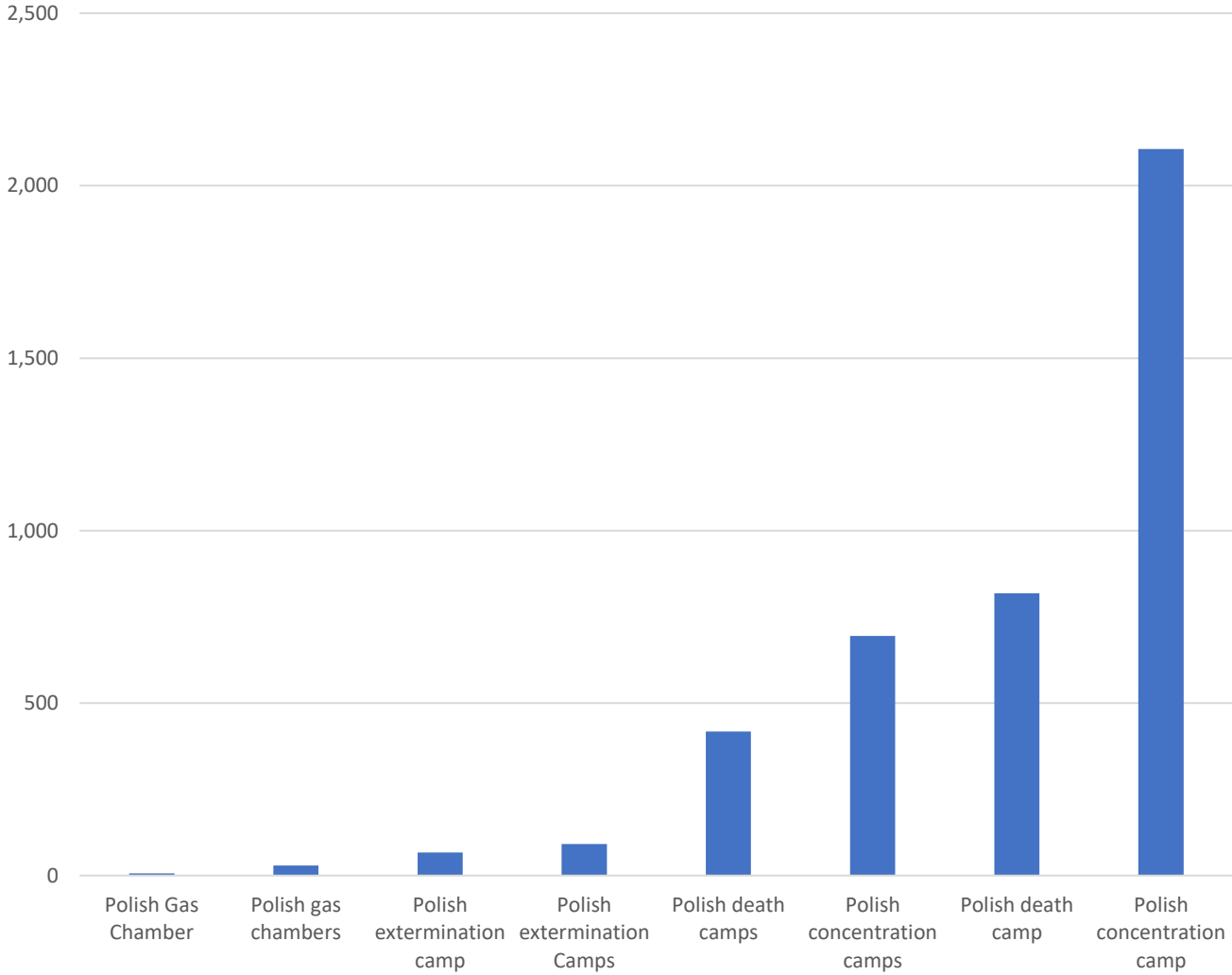

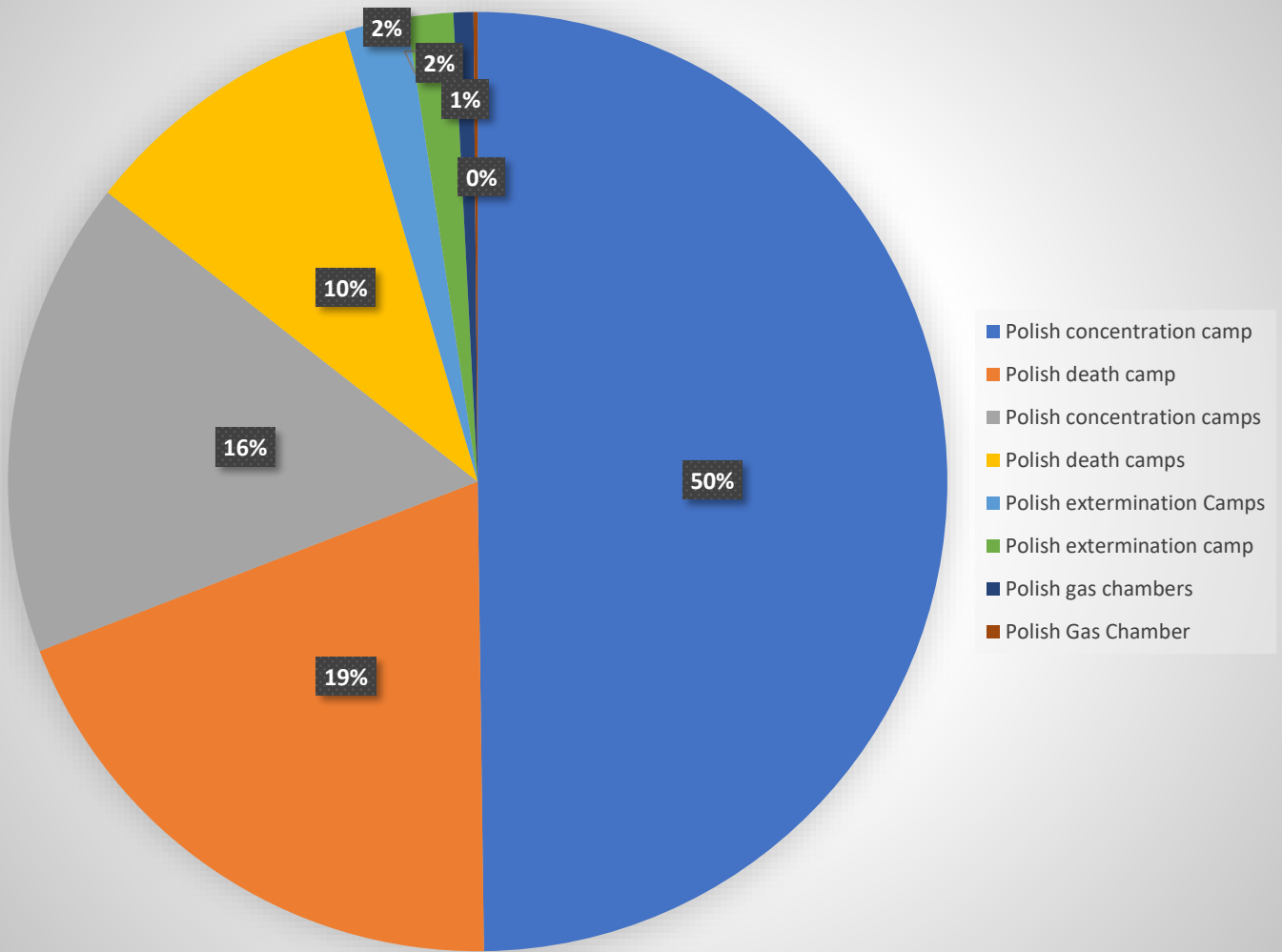
- By studying eight key phrases in relation to transferring German guilt on to Poles, EA-P will show when these issues became common.

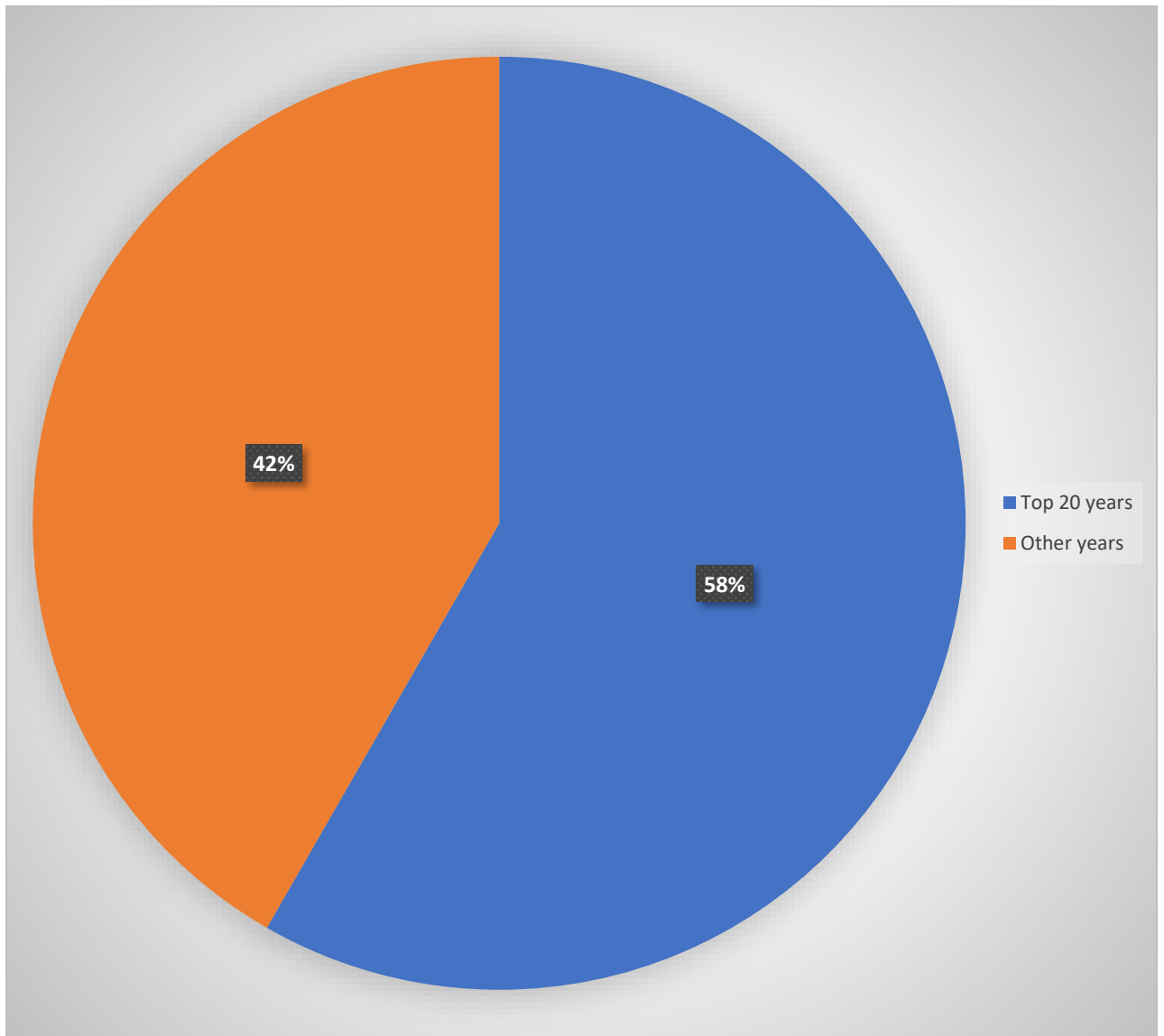

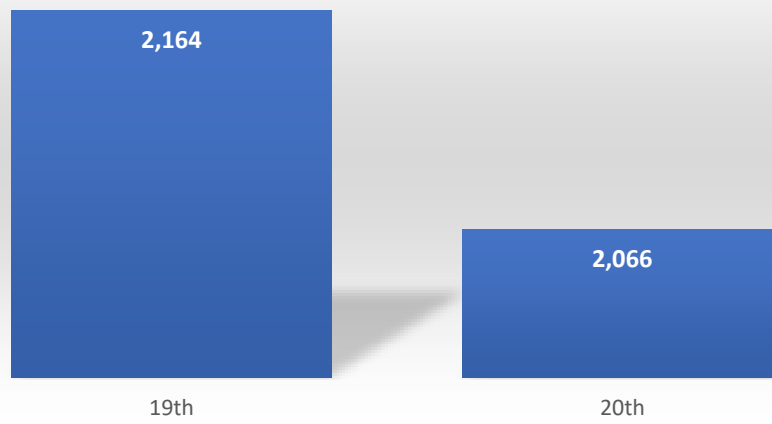

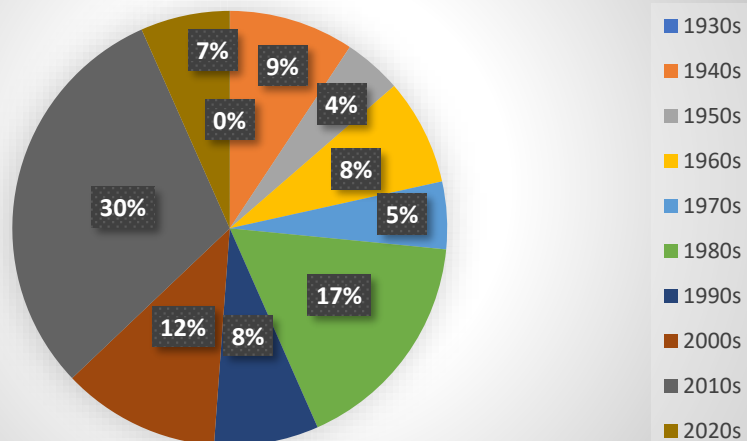
Breakdown by century
